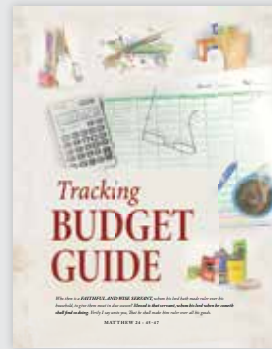

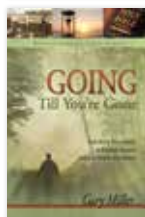
Charting a Course in Your Youth GARY MILLER

Jesus and Proverbs GARY MILLER

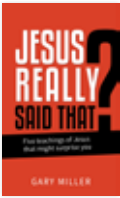
Can the teachings of Proverbs regarding wealth and business be reconciled with the teachings of Jesus? How should we view money?

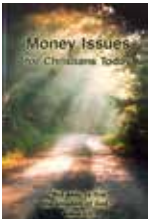
Life in a Global Village GARY MILLER

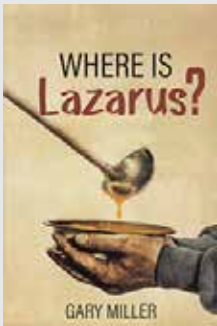
This Side of the Global Wall GARY MILLER
